

- The Pre-Cana, Catechism and Natural Family Planning Seminars will be announced by the Parish Church upon their completion of their requirements.
- There will also a publication of banns with a fee of P300.00 and will be announced twice to the public during masses.
- The Mass Wedding will be on February 14, 2023, 10:00am at the Parish of the Last Supper followed by simple reception at the CITHM Lobby.
- After the Wedding, the RFEWA Officers will submit the Certificates of Marriage of the couples to the City Civil Registry Office for Registration.
